EXPENDITURE FOR 2016

At Bampton during 2016 we used Whitechapel Bell Foundry to overhaul our clappers and to undertake a few other basic repairs. We invested a further £1,000 in the Bampton long term bell major works fund and we donated £1,000 to Bampton PCC Fabric Fund. We also spent some money on books and training materials and we had a few bell ropes repaired. Therefore at the 1st. January 2017 we had a surplus of £2,267.53 in our Bellringers Fund.

At Huntsham during 2016 we used Whitechapel Bell Foundry to make some adjustments to obtain even clapping, and we used Sound and Rigging Solutions to upgrade the sound control system. We invested a further £1,000 in the Huntsham long term bell major works fund and we donated £700 to Huntsham PCC. Therefore at the 1st January 2017 we had a surplus of £1,415.00 in the Huntsham Troyte Bell Fund.

We have not asked either PCC to make any contribution to the costs involved in running the Troyte Ringing Centre or to the costs of ringing or maintaining the bells, frames or other bell related equipment in either tower.
