

RISK ASSESSMENT POLICY STATEMENT

Introduction

This policy is written to acknowledge the Trustees' responsibility to identify, assess and manage risks.

Risk Assessment

A thorough risk assessment was made of those parts of the buildings which are central to the TRC Bellringing activities - Huntsham Church and Bampton Church. The assessment covered access to the site, entry to the building as well as the actual bellringing activity and activities associated with it. The written document was transposed in to a 3 column chart and is available to view on the TRC website.

The Risk Assessment Review

The Risk Assessment will be reviewed on any change of circumstance i.e. change of personnel, change in equipment, change in location.

The Risk Assessment will be looked at as part of an annual review in line with the TRC Annual Report

The Risk Assessment will be reviewed on a change of applicable legislation.

The Risk Assessment will be reviewed after an accident or near miss.

Ongoing Risk Assessment

The TRC Trustees are committed to ongoing careful examination of what is likely to cause harm.

We have standardised blank forms in a shared folder to be completed as deemed necessary for one off events (Teddy Bear Parachuting, coffee mornings) as well as Ringing Outings, Special Practices and Events

Throughout the teaching and practice of bellringing we start with safety guidelines.
